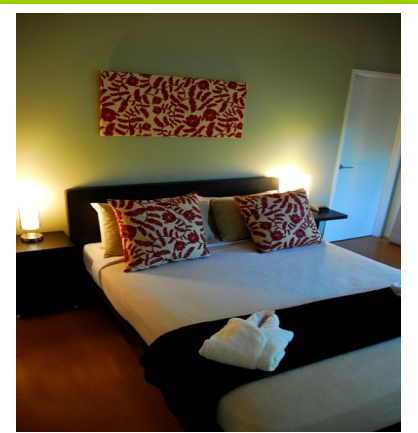
About Noosa

What to bring

- Small 3cup teapot. Small round Chinese teapots are perfect our purpose.
- 8 ply wool £ 2 balls main colour, 5 different coloured balls (or wool from your stash). For the best results, choose colours you love and wool you love. If in doubt about the amount, bring more rather than less, giving yourself a decent stash to choose from. If you have any fancy wools bring a choice of those too.
- 2 pairs of 5mm circular needles 60 cm length from tip to tip.

NOTE:

If you don't own these already, purchase a good brand, something like Addi Turbo Circular needles or Knit Pro or Knit Picks, you'll love using them and you'll have them forever.

- 1 pair of 4 mm regular knitting needles
- 1 pair of 4 mm double pointed needles
- 100g of poly fill
- note book (not too small)
- HB pencil
- Scissors
- wool darning needle
- 1 x 4mm crochet hook
- Feathers, buttons, beads £ whatever takes your fancy
- Lead sinkers or glass marbles

There will be some wool available for sale at the workshop but be sure to have your own knitting needles and tea pot and all other paraphernalia.
